On 03.11.2023, on the website of UNICEF, "Joint statement by UNICEF, WHO, UNFPA and UNRWA on Women and newborns bearing the brunt of the conflict in Gaza" was published. In this statement, is was stated that as of 3 November, according to Ministry of Health data, 2326 women and 3760 children have been killed in the Gaza strip, representing 67% of all casualties, thousands more have been injured, and there are an estimated 50.000 pregnant women in Gaza, with more than 180 giving birth every day, who are unable to access the emergency obstetric services they need to give birth safely and care for their newborns.
